The Victorian Age

- Futurism
 - Futurist manifesto (1910)
 - Glorifying the future, not the past
 - Industrial and urban romanticism
 - Worship of machines
 - Representation of motion (multiple overlapped images of the same object as it moves)
 - Concerned with the time dimension (whereas cubism was concerned with space and impressionism with light)

The Victorian Age

- Futurism
 - Filippo Marinetti (1876, Italy)
 - Writing is a visual art
 - Inspired by Mallarme’s “Un coup de des jamais n’abolira le hasard/ A throw of the dice will never abolish chance” (1897) and Apollinaire’s “Calligrammes” 1918)




The Victorian Age

- Futurism
 - Balla & Fortunato Depero (1892): “Futurist Reconstruction of the Universe” (1915), a catalog of futuristic machines: manifesto of kinetic art
 - Marinetti’s “Il Tattilismo” (1921): manifesto of interactive art (“A visual sense is born in the fingertips”)






